Equipment

Students should bring a chromebook and all equipment needed to lessons.

Food

Students are strongly advised to bring a packed lunch. A limited menu will be available from Innovate Cafe at lunch time. Year 12 are expected to use ILC and the SOcial area at lunch and break times.

School Day

We have adjusted timetables to allow students in Year 13 to take some of their independent learning sessions at home. We have also scheduled up to one online lesson a week per subject. Again these online lessons could be taken at home. Students should arrive for 9.05am if they have a timetabled lesson and go directly to first class for the day where they will be registered unless they have study leave The school day will end at 4.15pm on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday, Friday and 2.20pm on Wednesday.

Dress Code

We ask that you dress in a sensible and comfortable way. Extreme fashion or offensive logos are not allowed. We would ask you to wear shoes not sandals. Tops should cover shoulders and midriffs and trousers should be full length and not shorts.

Lanyards
