

SCHOOL TRAVEL ADVICE

Cramlington Learning Village is best accessed on foot or by bicycle from anywhere in the town. We strongly encourage students to travel in this way, particularly if they live in Cramlington.



Cramlington is designed with an extensive footpath & a cycleway network for ease of getting from A to B (see Cycleways Tube Map)



It is recommended that children of secondary school age exercise for at least 1 hour per day - walking is beneficial to physical & mental health



Wearing a helmet when cycling to school is strongly advised



Parking on site is for staff & visitors only



Public parking is available elsewhere in the town for meeting your child after school



There is a 10mph speed limit when driving on the school site



School is accessible from all parts of the town - the longest door-to-door walk is only 45 minutes



Safe storage for bikes & scooters is available on site



School is located on the main bus routes through the town with frequent services



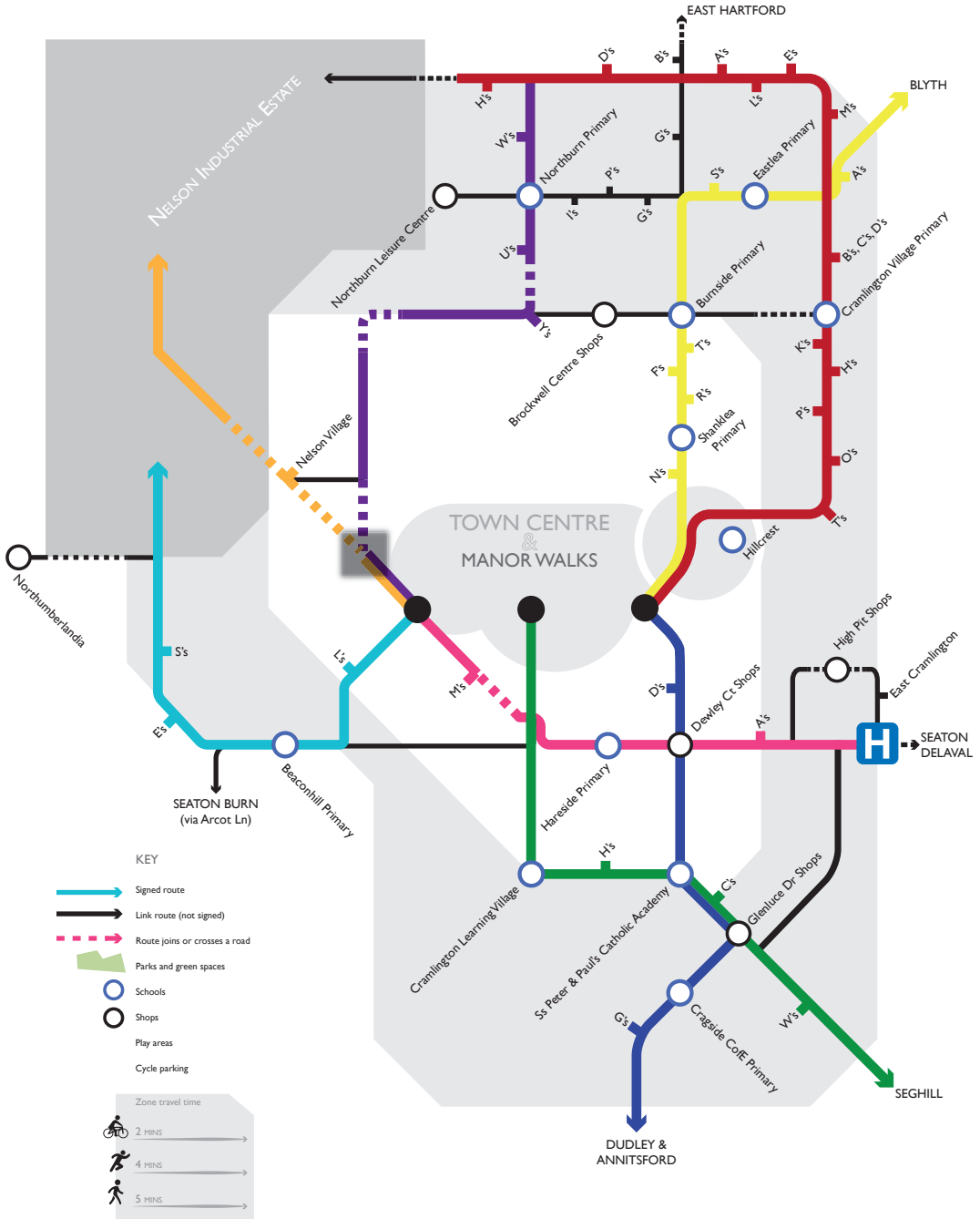
Our surrounding housing estates are not for parking, care & consideration is requested
