

SCHOOL TRAVEL ADVICE

Cramlington Learning Village is best accessed on foot or by bicycle from anywhere in the town. We strongly encourage students to travel in this way, particularly if they live in Cramlington.



Cramlington is designed with an extensive footpath & a cycleway network for ease of getting from A to B

School is accessible from all parts of the town - the longest door-to-door walk is only 45 minutes



It is recommended that children of secondary school age exercise for at least 1 hour per day - walking is beneficial to physical & mental health

Storage for bikes & scooters is available on site. Use of a secure lock is required to reduce risk of theft



Wearing a helmet when cycling to school is strongly advised





If you have to travel by road, we recommend using public transport.

School is located on the main bus routes through the town with frequent services



Parking on site is for staff & visitors only

Our surrounding housing estates are not for parking, care & consideration is requested



Public parking is available elsewhere in the town for meeting your child after school

School pick up should be a last resort & care for pedestrians is requested - do not block the school drive or wait on footpaths



There is a 10mph speed limit when driving on the school site
